Friday, August 10, 2018

Depart Rochester and travel to Cape Cod, MA. Welcome to the sandy shores of Cape Cod. Your local guide will meet you at the hotel, the **Holiday Inn, Hyannis, MA** for the next 3 nights. Each person will receive a print by a local artist just for coming along. **Lobster dinner** is included this evening. Alternate entrees will be available for any "landlubbers" not wishing to eat shellfish.

SATURDAY, AUGUST 11, 2018

Breakfast is included this morning at your hotel.

Your Local Guide will meet you at your hotel for a full day of touring. You will travel **historic Route 6A**, the Old King's Highway, a scenic byway winding through centuries of Cape Cod history. It winds past hundreds of historic structures which characterize its early development. Continue your travels as you view the **Eastham Windmill**, a Cape Cod Lighthouse and visit the **Cape Cod National Seashore Visitors Center**. Sand dunes and the ocean surround you as you approach "Land's End" – Provincetown. You are now at the extreme tip of Cape Cod. Formerly known as the "Province Lands" the pilgrims landed here first before they decided to settle across the Bay in Plymouth. Take some time to enjoy the wonderful variety of restaurants, shops, and galleries that make this artists/fishermen village so unique.

Board an excursion vessel for an amazing experience of **Whale Watching**. You will travel into the natural habitat of a diverse marine environment including birds that migrate here from all over the Atlantic, and fish which use these shallow waters to feed. Try to spot Humpback, Minke, and Fin Whales going about their daily business. An onboard naturalist will introduce you to everything you see and will answer any of your questions about the whales, birds, fish and lighthouses.



OR YOU MAY CHOOSE TO STAY ON DRY LAND:

Admission is included this afternoon on a **Dune Tour excursion**. Ride through the protected lands of the Cape Cod National Seashore, the largest protected coastline in the country. Your driver/guide will point out the "dune shacks" where famous artists and writers became inspired to create their art.

Dinner is on you own this evening in Provincetown. Your guide will offer suggestions.

SUNDAY, AUGUST 12, 2018

Breakfast is included this morning at your hotel.

Your local guide will meet you at your hotel and will conduct a **tour of Hyannis** which will include the John F. Kennedy Memorial, the Korean War Memorial, Hyannis port and a view of St. Francis Xavier Church, the summer parish of the Kennedy Family.

Welcome aboard a one-hour **Hyannis Harbor Cruise**. Get to know the local landmarks, popular beaches and other points of interest on your way to the historic Kennedy Compound.

OR YOU MAY CHOOSE TO STAY ON DRY LAND:

Admission is included today to the **John F. Kennedy Hyannis Museum**. The seas and shores of Hyannis Port inspired our 35th President like no other place on earth. It was here that he contemplated and accepted his run for office. Discover why he loved this place so, and how he spent his time on Cape Cod. *"I always go to Hyannis Port to be revived, to know again the power of the sea and the master who rules over it and all of us."* **John Fitzgerald Kennedy**.

There will be free time for lunch on your own on Main Street.

Return to your hotel to rest and freshen up for this afternoon's highlight. Admission is included this afternoon to Cape Cod's single largest cultural event, the **33rd Annual Pops by the Sea Concert**. The Arts Foundation of Cape Cod welcomes one of the nation's finest and best-loved musical ensembles – the Boston Pops Esplanade Orchestra to the Hyannis Village Green, conducted by Keith Lockhart.

Dinner is included this evening at your hotel.

MONDAY, AUGUST 13, 2018
